ATTENTION

Maximum number of people allowed in this church: 100 persons

PROHIBITED ENTRY:

Anyone with body temperature equal to or greater than 37.5 C (99.5 F) or who has had contact with someone who has tested positive with the Corona Virus (COVID19) in the past two weeks.

EVERYONE IS OBLIGATED TO:

- Enter and exit only through indicated doors, respecting a distance of 1.50 meters from others
- **Wear a mask (except when receiving communion)**
- Avoid gatherings in the churchyard and in the church before, during and after the celebration
- Maintain a distance of at least 1 meter from the person seated next to you
- Do not exchange the sign of peace
- Receive Holy Communion according to the directions of the celebrant
- Sanitize your hands upon entry into the church
- Sit only in designated spaces
- Offerings for the support of the parish can be made in the baskets provided, according to the directions of the celebrant
